

## **Extended Services Consultation**

Thank you to all of you who were able to return your completed extended services consultation. We had a 27% response rate and the findings are summarised below.

### **Holiday Clubs**

The main reason people stated for not attending the holiday clubs was that they had other plans on those days. Other reasons included not having any transport, the distance from home, work commitments and the fact that their child needed medication and feeds.

Those that had attended were happy with the holiday clubs but it was noted that a lot of parents would like more days.

### **Family Sessions**

The main reason people stated for not attending the family days was that they had other plans on those days. Times, especially for working parents, the distance to travel and a lack of transport were also factors.

Those that had attended were happy with the family days.

### **After School Clubs**

There were a diverse range of reasons given as to why children did not attend after-school club eg distance from home, wanting to spend the time as a family, children choosing not to attend.

Those that attended were happy with the provision.

### **Action Plan**

We are sending questionnaires home for you to complete with your child to establish what they would like to see offered at clubs. We will also be using some opportunities in school to talk to pupils about this.

Contact parents/carers who are registered for Free School Meals about the financial support that we can offer with transport.

Ensure that parents are aware that we are able to meet medication/feed requirements.

It is difficult for us to extend the number of days or times that we offer due to the very high cost of providing the clubs and other commitments that staff have.

Change family events to a different day of the week.
